Topics

Dates for your diary

This term, we are hoping to visit Sundown Adventure land as part of our Toys topic. We will update you as soon as we have any further information.

Homework/Reading

- Each Friday the children will bring home either a Maths or Literacy focused homework task. This will need to be completed and handed in by the following Wednesday. Homework will be marked and kept in the children's homework folders so you can see how they have done.
- The children will also bring home 5 - 10 spellings to learn which follow a particular spelling rule. These are all taught in school before they are sent home to practice.
- Reading at home is essential. The children will read to a member of staff and have their books changed every week. Each time your child reads they earn 10 points towards our reading air miles challenge, where the children can receive rewards. Please try to read with your child daily and please ensure that their reading book and reading record comes to school everyday.

Uniform

Please see the website for a correct list of the school uniform. School uniform is expected to be worn every day apart from the days your child does PE (see below for more details).

Please remember to label all uniform to prevent it from getting lost.

PE

Our PE day this half term is on Tuesday in week 1 and Thursday in week 2. Please ensure your child comes to school in the correct kit. This should include their P.E. hoody. Please see the school website for the correct kit. Children can wear long bottoms in cold weather—please be aware that PE lessons may take place outside so correct kit including appropriate footwear is essential.

Earrings

Due to Health & Safety in school, earrings are not allowed. Please ensure that your child removes their earrings or clear retainers before they come to school. Plasters over the ears will not be acceptable. Failure to do so may lead to the child missing PE and break times.

Other key information

Please ensure your child brings their own filled water bottle into school daily. There will be no cups or jugs in school. Only water is allowed for school. Please make sure that their water bottle has their name written on it.
