Topics

Our topic this half term is Europe and is our Geography focus. You can see all the work we will be doing in each subject in our long term plans on the school website. Homework/Reading

Homework will be set on a Friday and must be returned to school by the following Friday. We will spend time in school as a whole class going through it, this will give me the opportunity to clear up any misconceptions.

We are almost at the end of the homework booklets. When they are all completed, children will be given longer practice papers in Maths, Reading and Grammar as homework in preparation for SATs. These will still be given out every Friday to be returned for the following Friday. They will be paper copies and not sent via dojo, so the children can still go through them in class at the end of the week.

Children are required to read to an adult at home daily, this can be recorded in their reading passport. This will be monitored in school throughout the year and certificates are awarded when a new destination has been reached. Your child will also receive 1 dojo point for every day that they read at home.

Uniform

Please see the website for a correct list of the school uniform. School uniform is expected to be worn every day apart from the days your child does PE (see below for more details).

<u>PE</u>

Our PE day is Friday. Please ensure your child <u>comes to school</u> in the correct kit. Please see the school website for the correct kit. Children can wear tracksuits if the weather is an issue – please be aware that PE lessons may take place outside so correct kit including appropriate footwear is essential.

Earrings

Due to Health & Safety in school, earrings are not allowed. Please ensure that your child removes their earrings or clear retainers before they come to school. Plasters over the ears will not be acceptable. Failure to do so may lead to the child missing PE and break times.
