<u>Topics</u>

This half term we will be continuing with our topic 'Whose house is this?' based on the History of the local area during the Victorian period. Children will be learning about what life was like for regular people living in Barnsley during the 1800s. We will also be learning how to draw Victorian portraits in Art. In Science our new topic will be 'Growing Plants'. In RE our topic is 'Salvation' with a focus on Lent. Homework/Reading

English and Maths Homework will be set every Friday to be returned the following Wednesday. Each child will be given a homework folder with the worksheets inside to complete. It will then be marked in school and kept in the folder for you to see the following week.

The spellings taught in school will be posted on class Dojo to practise. There is no expectation to hand spellings back in, the more practise at home the better!

It is important that your child reads regularly to an adult at home, every day if possible. Your child will read one to one with an adult in school and their book will be changed once a week. It is important that your child re-reads their reading book to build up fluency and understanding. The more your child reads, the more reading miles they will earn!

<u>Uniform</u>
