


#### **Parents Evening**

#### Uniform

Please ensure correct uniform is worn to school including the correct PE kit. These are clearly displayed on our website. A reminder that due to Health and Safety in school, earrings are not allowed. Please ensure that your child removes their earrings and replaces them with clear retainers before they come to school. Plasters over the ears will not be acceptable. Clear retainers are not allowed in PE. A reminder that school hoodies must only be worn on PE/sports club days and not every day. Nail polish/false nails are not allowed.

#### Milk and snack

Milk is available from Cool Milk and information is available by contacting the school. Milk cannot be brought into school from home. Tuck shop is open for healthy snack (breadsticks and Snack-a-jacks) and items costs 25p. If you are sending in a snack from home, please ensure it is healthy e.g. fruit. Fruit is provided for Reception and KS1 (Years 1 and 2) as part of a government scheme. Please ensure your child brings a filled water bottle (water only please) into school daily for throughout the day.

Any concerns you have regarding your child, issues in class or concerns you wish to share, should be firstly discussed with the staff within the classroom who work with your child. This then allows for there to be clear progression to myself if and when needed. The class staff are always available for a quick chat in the morning or after school. If longer time is needed, please phone to arrange a longer phone call or meeting at a mutually convenient time. Staff are busy working with your child during the day so cannot meet with parents - please do not turn up unannounced as staff will not be available. We also have our Learning Mentor, Mrs Hewitt, and our Pupil Support Officer, Mrs Wiles, who will be able to give you a call if requested. Again, they are busy running various interventions and supporting pupils throughout the day so please do not turn up expecting them to be available.

#### Absence/Attendance

A polite reminder to please inform school (via the Gateway app or by phone 01227 704550) of your child's absence **for each day** they are off. This saves us then having to call you to find out why your child is not in school. Please do not use Class Dojo for this as the teachers are teaching and may not see your message. A reminder that school starts at 8:45 for Nursery and Reception and 8:55am for Years 1-6.
