Topics

Homework/Reading

Homework will be set on a Friday and must be returned to school by the following Friday. Dojo points will be awarded for homework completed and handed in on time. We will spend time in school as a whole class going through it, this will give me the opportunity to clear up any misconceptions.

We are nearing the end of these booklets. When they are completed, alternative reading and Maths homework will be sent home on Fridays to be completed in the same way and returned the following Friday.

Once we have completed the SATs there will be no more homework set for Year 6 – they have worked hard enough this year and deserve a rest!

Children are required to read to an adult at home daily, this can be recorded in their reading passport. This will be monitored in school throughout the year and certificates are awarded when a new destination has been reached. Your child will also receive 1 dojo point for every day that they read at home.

<u>Uniform</u>

Please see the website for a correct list of the school uniform. School uniform is expected to be worn every day apart from the days your child does PE.

<u>PE</u>

Our PE day this half term is every **Monday**. Please ensure your child <u>comes to school</u> in the correct kit. Please see the school website for the correct kit. Please be aware that PE lessons may take place outside so correct kit including appropriate footwear is essential.

Earrings

Due to Health and Safety in school, metal earrings are not allowed. Please ensure that your child removes their metal earrings before they come to school. Plasters over the ears will not be acceptable. Your child will not be able to take part in PE with metal earrings in.

If you wish your child to wear earrings, clear plastic earrings are allowed as they do not rip the ear if accidentally pulled. However, these cannot be worn for PE so the child must be able to remove them. Staff are not allowed to remove earrings.
