Dear Parent/Carer

Transition days for our new year 7 students will take place on Monday 3rd July and Tuesday 4th July next week and we are excited to meet everyone.

Here is some information about the two transition days and what your child can expect.

Students need to arrive at 8:30am and come straight into the main reception. Staff will be there to show the students to the Performance Hall where Worship will begin at 8:45am.

Following Worship, students will be told which form group they are going to be in and will then go with their form tutor to their form room to complete activities.

During the morning, students will be sorting their finger print for the school gateway cashless catering system, have their photo taken for their ID card and will have a tour of the school to get to know their way around.

Throughout the afternoon, the students will take part in fun team building activities with their new Head of Year.

Break time will be 10:45-11:15am. Students can purchase food and drinks and get to meet other students at Holy Trinity. Information about how to put money onto their accounts can be found on the Holy Trinity Website. Students can also bring cash to pay for food.

Lunchtime will be 12pm – 1pm. Students can again buy food and drinks or bring a packed lunch.

At the end of the day, students will all meet again in the Performance Hall at 2.45pm and leave through the main entrance at 3pm. Parents/carers can meet their child outside the main entrance, not inside.

The parents transition meeting will take place at 6pm on Monday 3rd July. We have 3 uniform providers attending the meeting where you can purchase uniform for September. Information about Holy Trinity School Uniform has been updated on the website following feedback from students, parents/carers and staff.

On Tuesday 4th July, students will arrive at 8:30am and go straight to the performance hall. From 9am, they will follow a timetable and have the opportunity to have taster sessions in a variety of subjects. Break and lunch times will remain the same and students will leave at 3pm through the main entrance.
