Dear Year 11 Parent/Carer

As you will be aware, Y11 are coming towards the end of their formal exams. They will officially leave school on Thursday 8th June.

I am writing to clarify arrangements for the leavers celebrations on Thursday 8th June 2023. We ask that students wear full school uniform on this day and, if they wish to have their shirt signed, they bring an additional shirt or wait until after the final liturgy.

The school day will begin as normal at 8.45am and all students must go straight to their form room, on the Maths corridor. Throughout the morning students will take part in a liturgy and a leavers assembly, and some quality time together for farewell messages and shirt signing. Students will then be dismissed.

We hope that our Y11's final school day will provide an opportunity for students to reflect on all the positive memories they have made at Holy Trinity, and on how much they have grown as individuals during their time with us.

There are a few final exams still to be completed over the next two weeks. Students must arrive to exams ten minutes before the exam start time is scheduled unless they wish to attend the booster session beforehand. Times and classrooms are outlined on their examination timetable and a copy can be found on the school website.

GCSE examinations results day is on Thursday 24th August. Students can attend school to collect their results between 10am and 11am in person on this day; results will be issued from the heartspace. If a parent wishes to collect results on their child's behalf they must have a signed written note of consent from the student who has taken the exams.
