Welcome to our half-termly newsletter, which aims to share with you the key information you need to know this half term.

Topics

Our topic this half term is the First World War and is our History focus. You can see all the work we will be doing in each subject in our long term plans on the school website. Homework/Reading

Homework will be set on a Friday and must be returned to school by the following Friday. We will spend some time on Fridays going through each test so the children can self-mark and see where they might have gone wrong, then they will take the books home again to compete the next set of tests. Dojo points will be awarded for homework completed and handed in on time. Children should complete one test in each booklet every week.

Children are required to read to an adult at home daily, this can be recorded in their reading passport. This will be monitored in school throughout the year and certificates are awarded when a new destination has been reached. Your child will also receive 1 dojo point for every day that they read at home.

There is also a lunchtime homework club available to access should anyone need support or extra time to complete it.

Tutoring

Mr Robson will be teaching tutoring sessions for reading, writing and maths. You will be contacted via dojos if your child is involved in those sessions. A new round of sessions will begin in the Spring term based on Autumn mock SATS assessments.

Uniform

Please see the website for a correct list of the school uniform. School uniform is expected to be worn every day apart from the days your child does PE (see below for more details). Please also note that smart watches are not allowed to be worn in school.

<u>PE</u>

Our PE days this year are Mondays and Thursdays every week. Please ensure your child <u>comes to school</u> in the correct kit. Please see the school website for the correct kit. Please be aware that PE lessons may take place outside so correct kit including appropriate footwear is essential.
