# **Topics**

Our topic this term is Extreme Earth and is our Geography focus. This half term we will be looking at volcanoes, eruptions, and the effects they have. In Science, we are learning about forces and magnets, and our new science work includes lots of science investigations. ## Homework / Reading

We will send homework on Fridays to be returned any time before Friday of the following week. Homework will be a piece of Maths work, a piece of English work and fortnightly spellings. Homework will be marked by one of the class team and the children will earn Dojos for bringing their homework in. There are also lunch time homework clubs where the children can complete their homework, should they forget to at home.

Children are advised to read to an adult daily. Daily reads can be recorded in the air miles reading record book and the children will also be rewarded with Dojo points.
