Dear Year 11 Parent/Carer

As you will be aware, Year 11 start their formal written exams this week. Whilst examinations get underway, students will continue to attend school to finish covering their curriculums and revise in a guided way with their teachers.

On **Monday, 3rd June after their morning examination and 'Leavers' celebration assembly and liturgy**, all students will commence 'Study Leave' which means they can continue to revise at home independently and attend school only for their timetabled examinations. However, all teachers will be available during their Year 11 timetabled lesson time to support pupils with their exam preparation, should your child wish to attend the lesson for guided revision and support.

Please note, morning examinations start at 9am (with revision booster sessions starting at 8.30am) and afternoon examinations start at 1pm (with revision booster sessions starting at 12.40pm). Please see the booster timetable for more information. If students choose not to attend booster sessions, they must arrive 10 minutes before the scheduled start time of each examination to place their belongings in lockers, use the toilet and get mentally prepared.

Students will be required to wear full uniform for all examinations. If they wish to have their shirt signed on Monday, 3rd June, they will need to bring an additional shirt or wait until after the final liturgy when students will be dismissed.

We hope that our Year 11's final school day will provide an opportunity for students to reflect on all the positive memories they have made at Holy Trinity, and on how much they have grown as individuals during their time with us.

GCSE examinations results day is on Thursday 22nd August. Students can attend school to collect their results between 10am and 11am in person on this day; results will be issued from the Performance Hall. If a parent wishes to collect results on their child's behalf they must have a signed written note of consent from the student who has taken the exams.
