Homework/Reading

- Each Friday the children will bring home either a Maths or Literacy focused homework task. This will need to be completed and handed in by the following Tuesday. Homework will be marked and kept in the children's homework folders so you can see how they have done.
- The children will also bring home 5 or 10 spellings to learn which follow a particular spelling rule. These are all taught in school before they are sent home to practice.
- Reading at home is essential. The children will read to a member of staff and have their books changed every Friday. Each time your child reads they earn points towards our reading air miles challenge, where the children can receive rewards. Please try to read with your children daily.

<u>Uniform</u>

Please see the website for a correct list of the school uniform. School uniform is expected to be worn every day apart from the days your child does PE (see below for more details). **Please remember to label all uniform to prevent it from getting lost.**

PE

Our PE days are Tuesday and Thursday. Please ensure your child <u>comes to school</u> in the correct kit, including their school PE hoodie. Please see the school website for the correct kit. Children can wear tracksuit bottoms if the weather is an issue – please be aware that PE lessons may take place outside so correct kit including appropriate footwear is essential.

Earrings

Due to Health & Safety in school, earrings are not allowed. Please ensure that your child removes their earrings or clear retainers before they come to school. Plasters over the ears will not be acceptable. Failure to do so may lead to the child missing PE and break times.

Other key information

Please ensure your child brings their own filled water bottle into school daily. There will be no cups or jugs in school. Only water is allowed for school. **Please make sure that their water bottle has their name written on it.**

Please could I ask that earrings are not worn for school. The children can wear clear spaces on days which they do not have PE.
