#### Dear Parent/Carer

Welcome to half-termly newsletter, which aims to share with you the key information you need to know this half term.

# **Topics**

Our topic this half term is 'Why is the UK a unique place to live?' and it is our Geography focus. We will be locating hills and rivers on maps and drawing our own sketch maps of the local area. We will also be comparing where we live to a coastal town. In science we will be learning about Health and Movement, looking closely at balanced diets and skeletons. Our English work this term will be based on 'The BFG' by Roald Dahl. In Art we will be exploring art through stories and we will be making our own BFG sculptures using clay. Our RE focus this half term is creation and we will be exploring all of the wonderful things that God created. ## Homework/Reading

We will send homework on Fridays to be returned any time before Friday of the following week. Homework will be a piece of Maths work, a piece of English work and weekly spellings. Homework will be marked throughout the week by one of the class team and the children will earn Dojos for bringing their homework in. There are also lunch time homework clubs where the children can complete their homework, should they forget to at home.

Children are advised to read to an adult daily. Daily reads can be recorded in the air miles reading record book. The children will also be rewarded with Dojo points, certificates, and raffle tickets each time they arrive at a new 'destination' in their reading records. A member of the class team will aim to read with each child throughout the week, so it is very important that they bring in their reading book and record daily.

#### Uniform

Our PE days are Monday and Friday each week. Please ensure your child <u>comes to school</u> in the correct kit. Please see the school website for the correct kit. Children with long hair will need to have their hair tied back.

Due to Health & Safety in school, earrings and clear retainers are not allowed. Please ensure that your child removes their earrings or clear retainers before they come to school. Plasters over the ears will not be acceptable. Failure to do so may lead to the child missing PE and break times.
