There is also a lunchtime homework club available to access should anyone need support or extra time to complete it. Children who do not hand their homework in on time will go to lunch time club on a Friday.

# <u>Reading</u>

Children are required to read to an adult daily at home, this can be recorded in their reading passport. This will be monitored in school throughout the year and certificates are awarded when they reach a new destination. Your child will receive 1 dojo point for every day they read at home and they will be entered in to our class reading raffle. Your child will read their level appropriate accelerated reading book to an adult in class at least once a fortnight. Please send the reading passport into school every day. We will send their accelerated reading book home every day but they may include any book into their passport.

### <u>Uniform</u>

Please see the website for a correct list of the school uniform. School uniform is expected to be worn every day apart from the days your child does PE (see below for more details).

## <u>PE</u>

Please ensure your child <u>comes to school</u> in the correct kit. Please see the school website for the correct kit. Children can wear tracksuits if the weather is an issue – please be aware that PE lessons may take place outside so correct kit including appropriate footwear is essential. No earrings or retainers allowed.
