<u>Topics</u>

Our topic this term is Coal Mining and is our History focus. This half term we will be investigating how coal is made. We will be learning about coal mining in the Victorian Era and about children's roles in the mines during this time. We will also link our work to the local area and the history of Mining in Barnsley. In DT we will be designing and making money containers. In English we will be continuing with our BFG book and we will be writing letters and newspaper reports.
