Dear Parent/Carer

Welcome to half-termly newsletter, which aims to share with you the key information you need to know this half term.

Topics

Our topic this half term is 'Coal mining' and it is our History focus. This half term we will be investigating how coal is made. We will be learning about coal mining throughout history and about children's roles in the mines. We will also link our work to the local area and the history of Mining in Barnsley. In DT we will be designing and making money containers. In English we will be continuing with our BFG book and we will be writing letters and newspaper reports. Homework/Reading

We will send homework on Fridays to be returned any time during the following week. Homework will be a piece of Maths work, a piece of English work and spellings every fortnight. Homework will be marked throughout the week by one of the class team and the children will earn Dojos for bringing their homework in. There are also lunch time homework clubs where the children can complete their homework, should they forget to at home.

Children are advised to read to an adult daily. Daily reads can be recorded in the air miles reading record book. The children will also be rewarded with Dojo points, certificates, and raffle tickets each time they arrive at a new 'destination' in their reading records. A member of the class team will aim to read with each child throughout the week, so it is very important that they bring in their reading book and record daily.

Uniform

PE

Our PE days are Monday and Friday each week. Please ensure your child <u>comes to school</u> in the correct kit. Please see the school website for the correct kit. Children with long hair will need to have their hair tied back.

Earrings

Due to Health & Safety in school, earrings and clear retainers are not allowed. Please ensure that your child removes their earrings or clear retainers before they come to school. Plasters over the ears will not be acceptable. Failure to do so may lead to the child missing PE and break times.
