Write paragraphs of varying lengths (40, 90 or 150 words) from memory using three tenses.

Translate short paragraphs from French to English in different tenses and on a wider range of topics.

Take part in conversations with no support on a range of topics.

Develop a range of strategies to answer a wide range of different listening tasks.

Translate accurately single sentences and short paragraphs from English to French in different tenses and on a wide range of topics.

Read and understand a wide range of different styles of writing (literary, journalistic, surveys..) and of varying lengths.

Take part in a role-play and answer questions spontaneously and unprepared.

Avoid distractors in listening tasks.

Recognise a wide range of key words used in different contexts.

Write simple sentences to describe a photo accurately with no support.

Translate accurately single sentences from English to French in different tenses on a range of topics with no support.

Write accurate small paragraphs in the **present, past and future tense** on a range of topics with no support.

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Answer questions confidently with no support on a range of topics.

Translate accurately single sentences or small paragraphs from French to English in different tenses on a range of topics.

Understand and use a wider range of pronouns.

Listen to recordings on different topics and make notes in English and in French.

Be aware of distractors in listening tasks.

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Write small paragraphs in the **present, past and future tense** with no or very little support.

Use new ways of opening sentences to express opinions.

Understand more complex opinions (positive, negative or positive and negative)

Understand more opinions about a range of different topics in the **present, past and future tense**.

Use the conditional confidently with a range of infinitives.

Give people advice to suggest improvements.

Read authentic material about some current issues.

Answer questions in the **present, past and future tense** with some support.

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Use comparatives with a range of adjectives.

Understand and use a range of sentence starters to express opinions.

Use a wider range of topic specific verbs in the **present, past and future tense**.

Write simple sentences accurately in the **present, past and future tense** with no or very little support.

Understand more opinions about a range of different topics in the **present, past and future tense**.

Read some authentic material.

Say **simple sentences** which contain a verb with confidence.

Recognise more cognates.

Become aware of the concept of feminine and masculine nouns.

Give opinions and reasons in one single sentence

Say **single words** with confidence.

Copy **single words** accurately.
