There is also a lunchtime homework club available to access should anyone need support or extra time to complete it. Children who do not hand their homework in on time will go to lunch time club on a Friday.

Your child will access TTrockstars in school. Please encourage your child to access this at home as much as possible especially as they have the Year 4 Multiplication check in June 2025.

# **Reading**

We have some changes to reading. We are now delivering reading fluency lessons four times a week. Your child will read extensively during these sessions exploring a range of texts and genres. This will replace us writing in the reading passports once a fortnight as before. These are for you to continue to record when your child reads to you at home (this can be the accelerated reading book or a free choice book at home). Every time your child reads, at home they will receive a Dojo at school (we will tick off when the Dojos have been awarded as before.) They will also receive certificates and raffle tickets every time they reach a new destination. Please continue to bring reading books and passports into school daily as before so we can reward reading!

# <u>Uniform</u>

Please see the website for a correct list of the school uniform. School uniform is expected to be worn every day apart from the days your child does PE (see below for more details).

# <u>PE</u>

Please ensure your child <u>comes to school</u> in the correct kit. Please see the school website for the correct kit. Children can wear tracksuits if the weather is an issue – please be aware that PE lessons may take place outside so correct kit including appropriate footwear is essential. No earrings or retainers allowed.

### Earrings

Due to Health & Safety in school, earrings are not allowed. Please ensure that your child removes their earrings. They may wear clear retainers when it is not their PE day. Plasters over the ears will not be acceptable. Failure to do so may lead to the child missing PE.

On a Wednesday morning Year 4 will be learning to play brass instruments! Your child will be allocated a trumpet or cornet and when they are taken home they need to be returned for the following Wednesday. We do not have the space to store these in our classroom.
