Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back to the second half of the Spring Term 2025. We will continue to give out extra certificates for **responsibility** this term. As mentioned last half term, part of this strand is coming to school in the correct uniform. Please support the pupils by ensuring they are wearing full and correct uniform on normal school days and PE days. The full list of uniform is on the school website. Due to Health and Safety in school, **metal earrings are not allowed**. Please ensure that your child removes their metal earrings before they come to school. Plasters over the ears will not be acceptable. If you wish your child to wear earrings, clear plastic earrings are allowed as they do not rip the ear if accidentally pulled. However, **these cannot be worn for PE** so the child must be able to remove them. Staff are not allowed to remove earrings.

Please ensure names are in jumpers and cardigans – it makes giving them back to the right children so much easier and saves you losing items. A reminder that we have a rail of good quality second hand items which are <u>free</u> to you! Please find the rail in the primary entrance. Ties can be purchased from the main entrance to school.

A polite reminder to please inform school (via the Gateway app or by phone 01227 704550) of your child's absence **for each day** they are off. This saves us then having to call you to find out why your child is not in school. Please do not use Class Dojo for this as the teachers are teaching and may not see your message. A reminder that school starts at 8:45 for Nursery and Reception and 8:55am for Years 1-6.


