Dear Year 11 Parent/Carer,

As you will be aware, Year 11 start their formal written exams this week. Whilst examinations get underway, students will continue to attend school to finish covering their curriculums and revise in a guided and supported way with their teachers. It is essential that all students maintain full attendance during this period, as every lesson and revision session plays a vital role in preparing them thoroughly for their exams. Please note that any absences during this time will be recorded as unauthorised unless prior consent has been given by the school.

On Monday 16th June, after their morning Science examination, 'Leavers' celebration assembly and final liturgy, students will leave school for the last time (unless they have the music exam to take in the afternoon. If this is the case, they should remain in school until the music examination is finished in the afternoon).

Please note, morning examinations start at 9am (with revision booster sessions starting at 8.30am) and afternoon examinations start at 1pm (with revision booster sessions starting at 12.30pm). Please encourage your child to attend these boosters as they will receive last minute tips and advice to support them.

Just a reminder that students are required to wear full uniform for all examinations. If they wish to have their shirt signed on Monday 16th June, they will need to bring an additional shirt and wait until after the final liturgy when students will be dismissed.

We hope that our Year 11s' final school day will provide an opportunity for students to reflect on all the positive memories they have made at Holy Trinity, and on how much they have grown as individuals during their time with us.

GCSE examinations results day is on Thursday 21st August. Students can attend school to collect their results between 10am and 11am in person on this day; results will be issued from the Performance Hall. If a parent wishes to collect results on their child's behalf, they must have a signed written note of consent from the student who has taken the exams.
